

# CHECK OUT WHAT'S HAPPENING AT ST. PAUL'S

#### **FOOD PANTRY**

The food pantry is seeking donations of condiments (ketchup, mayo, salad dressing, barbecue sauce, jelly or jam, etc.) as well as baking mixes (cake, brownie, cookie). Requests for these items have exceeded the supply in the pantry. Other current needs include pasta sauce, hot cocoa mix, pancake mix, canisters of oatmeal, rice, and hearty soups. During a recent St. Vincent de Paul visit to a man who reported having no food in his apartment, we found that the cabinet was full of canned goods from a local food pantry. With myriad health problems, he couldn't use any of them. The extraordinary response to our requests allows us to avoid situations like this one.
