## THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Friends,

November is such a blessed month, not least in the ongoing opportunity and responsibility to pray for all those who have died. May they rest in peace!

As part of our prayers for those who have died, and as part of St. Paul's mission to support the intellectual and sacred music life of those here in Harvard Square and beyond, we encourage you to join us in the church this **Thursday, November 18. At 4:00pm**, we have a lecture by noted Harvard music professor Thomas Kelley regarding Faure's great *Requiem*. That will be followed by a celebration of Holy Mass at 5:00pm which will include the *Requiem*, as sung by our Choir of Men and Boys. This will be a time of prayer, learning, and beauty not to be missed!

This weekend, at our **second collection**, we are beginning our very important **Parish Grand Annual Appeal**. As we have been noting for over a month now, and in the letter that you should have received, we need an extra boost to help us with parish finances. We are asking each household to make a sacrificial offering of \$300, payable over the next several months if that is helpful. For me, the important thing is that everyone participates in the amount each is able; this effort should reflect the whole parish coming together to make us stronger! Thank You!

This week we also had a meeting of both the Finance Committee and the Parish Council. At the Parish Council, we talked through plans to assist our parishioners to participate in the ongoing survey initiated by Pope Francis as the church prepares for a Synod in the upcoming year. More to come. At the Finance Meeting, our Parish Director of Finance, Tom Hogan, announced his upcoming retirement. We have begun posting for the position in several suitable places, but if you know someone who might be interested in being considered for this work, be sure to point them in our direction!

Next **Sunday, November 21**, the Choir School will hold its annual Investiture ceremony, when those boys prepared to be received fully into the choir will receive their hymnal and surplice and make their promise of service to Almighty God. It will be at 12:30pm and lasts about a half hour. It is a lovely ceremony, and you are welcome to attend!

And on a musical note, many thanks to Fr. Patrick and his bandmates of Vatican III. It was wonderful to have such a fine evening of jazz and comradery. Harvard Square hasn't had such a fine Friday evening's entertainment in a long time!!
