We had almost 900 people at the Mass, and the crowd at Memorial Church in Harvard Yard maxed out at 1,000. Both his homily, his lecture and his generous interactions with so many people had a great impact on our community as well. You can see both events again on the YouTube channel on the Harvard Catholic Forum website. Special thanks to Deacon Tim O'Donnell and the HCC and parish staff who made it come together so well.

This week, we are visited by Fr. Sean McGillicuddy, a Redemptorist priest who will be sharing with us at Mass about his brother's missionary work in Brazil. Thank you for our warm welcome and financial support. I know we have, and will have, several second collections these days. There are many needs, and I thank you for your generosity as you are able.

Our renowned **RCIA program** for adults seeking entrance into the Catholic Church, along with adults seeking the Sacrament of Confirmation, is gearing up for another inspiring year, starting this Saturday, September 23; we already have more than 30 people signed up!
