### PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

Dear Friends,

Palm Sunday is the gateway to the holiest week of the Church's year. (Please remember that the **9:30 Mass begins at 9:00am on Palm Sunday and Easter**.) As much as you can, try to adapt your routine to mirror the events of these days. You can do certain things at home, but of course the most fulsome way is to join with the community's liturgies to enter the Lord's Passion, Death, and Resurrection with one heart and mind.

I would encourage you to look ahead to the schedule for Holy Week, the Sacred Triduum, and Easter. We encourage you all to join us for *sung Morning Prayer* on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday, facilitated by parishioner Paul Rose, of "Sing the Hours" acclaim. Please remember that on Easter the regular 9:30 Mass will begin instead at 9:00 am and this year we will not have an 11:00am lower church Mass on Easter, so plan accordingly to go to another Mass or to come early!

In preparation for Easter, we have added an extra opportunity for Confession: Wednesday, April 13, from 6:30pm-8:00pm. There will be five priests available. (Please note that there are no Thursday or Saturday afternoon Confessions this week.)

We will **decorate for Easter** on Saturday morning, **April 16 at 9:30am** (immediately following Morning Prayer.) All ages are welcome!
